Ryanair second flight from Larnaka to Barcelona (Girona) takes off 1 Million € 6*

Ryanair, the world's favourite airline, today (1st December) celebrates the start of its second flight to Larnaca from Barcelona (Girona) which will operate twice weekly on Wednesdays and Sundays.

To celebrate, Ryanair released 1million €6 seats for travel across its European network in January and February, which are available for booking on www.ryanair.com until midnight (24:00hrs) Thursday (2nd Dec).

Speaking today, Ryanair's Melisa Corrigan said:

"We are pleased to celebrate the launch of our second route to Larnaca.. Ryanair will continue to grow as other airlines pull routes and reduce capacity whilst incurring significant losses. With passengers becoming increasingly price sensitive, travellers to Cyprus can now take advantage of Ryanair's guaranteed lowest fares and no fuel surcharges. Ryanair's Cyprus routes will deliver 60,000 passengers p.a. at Larnaca and sustain 60 local jobs.

"To celebrate the commencement of the new route to Barcelona (Girona), Ryanair is offering 1million €6* seats for travel across its European network in January and February, which are only available for booking on www.ryanair.com until midnight Thursday (2nd Dec).
