


## I CAN FLY

— a step-by-step storybook — LARNAKA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT







Going on a trip can be super fun!
I might take an airplane when going
on a trip.



Airports can be busy places. It's very important that when I'm at the airport, I stay with my family.





The first thing I will need to do is go to the Airline Check-In Desk.

Here I need to show my Passport or ID and Ticket to pick up my Boarding Card.

If I am bringing luggage, I will need to check it in with the airline staff.

I will have to drop it off on a conveyor belt.

I will get my luggage back at Baggage Claim when the airplane lands.







It is now time to go for a Passport Control.

I will have to wait in queue patiently and show my Passport or ID to the Police Officer.












The next thing I need to do at the airport is to go through security.

I might need to wait in a long line, but that's okay.








When I get to the front of the security line, it is important that I listen to the Screening Officer.




The first thing I need to do is put my bag, jacket and hat in a plastic bin. The plastic bin will pass through an X-Ray Machine, and I will get all my things back on the other side.





Next, I should stand and look at the Screening Officer on the other side of the Metal Detector. The officer will say "go" when it is my turn to walk through.






I must always listen to the Screening Officer. I might be asked to stand still while they use their wand to scan my body or wipe my hands.





The Screening Officer might also look through my bag. After the Screening Officer is finished, I can grab my bag and put my jacket and hat back on.










Next, my family and I will look to see which gate our airplane is parked at. We can look at the Information Screen to find our Gate Number.



Then we will walk to the gate.





When we get to the gate, I might need to wait. There are lots of things that I can do while I am waiting. I can read a book. I can have a snack. I can play a game.
























The airline staff will make an announcement when it is time to get on the airplane. I need to listen carefully to my family. They will tell me when it is our turn.








I might need to wait in a line for my turn to get on the airplane. When it is my turn, my family will give our Boarding Cards to the gate agent.









Next, we will walk down a special tunnel that takes us to the airplane. When we get to the airplane, we might need to wait as others sit down and find their seats.

We might choose to put some things in the overhead bins or under the seat in front of us.




When I sit down in my seat, I will put my seat belt on. I will need to wait for everyone to find their seats.






Next, the airplane staff will make announcements. I should sit quietly and listen carefully. The staff will tell me when it is time for the airplane to take off.






If I need to go to the bathroom while I am on the airplane, I will ask my family to go with me.

The toilet will also make a loud noise when I flush it. That's okay.




The airplane staff will tell us when it is time to land. I should listen carefully. It is fun to feel the airplane go down, down, down back to the ground.

I should wait my turn to get off the airplane and gather my things from the overhead bins.









Yay! We're here!






I should stay close to my family as we walk to the Baggage Claim to pick up our luggage.



It's important that I wait patiently by the Baggage Carousel and stay close to my family.






When we see my luggage, I can step closer to the carousel with my family and get my luggage.
