Hermes Airports celebrates its 10th anniversary

Anniversary logo and a series of events to be held throughout the year

Hermes Airports, the operator of the Republic of Cyprus' two international airports, marks in 2016, 10 years of successful operation and significant contribution to the economy, society and tourism of Cyprus.

In the context of its 10 year anniversary celebrations, Hermes Airports has adopted a new anniversary logo highlighting the company's revamped profile and dynamic track record.
